### **FOI Query**

Please can you tell me whether the PCC, or any employee of the PCC's office, has been charged with any criminal offence since 1 January 2014, and if so: 1. The name of the individual concerned 2. The date set for their first appearance in court 3. What they were charged with.

### **Complaints**
