FOI Query

For each financial year since the position was created how much has the Office of Police and Crime Commissioner had to pay out in fines as a result of parking tickets issued to company cars?

Response

The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner has paid out £0 in parking tickets on company cars. The OPCC does not operate a company car scheme as such but does employees do have the use of two pool cars. The organisation's policy on the use of the pool cars states that: *The driver is liable for any parking fines, speeding tickets, clamping fees or offences.* Therefore the OPCC would not pay for any parking tickets.
