I would like to know how much money West Mercia PCC have given to the Ascension Trust/Street Pastors in the financial years 2012-2013, 2013-2014, 2014-2015, 2015-2016, as well as any payments made to date in the financial period 2016-2017. The Ascension Trust's charity number is 1127204. The 'Street Pastors' is a project run by the Ascension Trust. Can you please provide figures broken down into each financial year. If you could please email the information to this email address. Many thanks, Ben.

Response

There is no information for 2012 – 2013 as the scheme was not in place until 2013 – 2014, but the information you requested for 2013 – 2014, 2014 – 2015 and 2015 – 2016 is available on our website, <http://www.westmercia-pcc.gov.uk/Transparency/Grants/Grants-Scheme-2015---16.aspx> and the only payment made so far this financial year is £20,000 to Shrewsbury Street Pastors.

Complaints
