- S(2) 21 (1) Information which is reasonably accessible to the applicant otherwise than under section 1 is exempt information.

As the rest of the briefing contained information which is both personal and confidential. It is exempt from being disclosed under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 according to the below referenced exemptions;

- S(2) 23 Information supplied by, or relating to bodies dealing with security matters.
- S(2) 40 Personal information relating to a third party.
- S(2) 41 Information provided in Confidence.
