This decision notice seeks approval for the replacement of three vehicles that have been used previously for National Security (CT) operations.

**PROPOSAL**

The proposal is to purchase 3 standard specification vehicles that could, if necessary be reallocated into the fleet and be used on a daily basis. These vehicles meet the required needs for operations of this type, and can be sourced by the Fleet Manager within an adequate timeframe to enable the necessary adjustments to be fitted and supplied

**SUPPORTING REPORT**

To purchase 3 standard specification vehicles that could, if necessary be reallocated into the fleet and be used on a daily basis. These vehicles meet the required needs for operations of this type, and can be sourced by the Fleet Manager within an adequate timeframe to enable the necessary adjustments to be fitted and supplied.

These purchases are supported by the ACC.

**FINANCIAL COMMENTS**

The purchase costs are likely to be in the region of £11,000 for each of the two vehicles, based on a 12 month old vehicle with under 10,000 miles, while the purchase cost of the third vehicle is anticipated to be £14,998.

**LEGAL CONSIDERATIONS**

By virtue of schedule 11, paragraph 14 of the Police Reform and Social Responsibility Act 2011 the Police and Crime Commissioner may do anything which is calculated to facilitate, or is conducive or incidental to, the exercise of the functions of commissioner. That includes: entering into contracts and other agreements (whether legally binding or not) and acquiring and disposing of property (including land).
