#### **Freedom of Information Request.**

Under the freedom of information legislation, I am seeking the following information from the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for West Mercia:

- How many smartwater packs have been supplied to Wythall Division
- How many packs have been distributed to date to residents within Wythall Division
- What the cost of each pack was to the PCC.
- How many packs has NAME has paid for and at what unit price.

#### **Response.**

The cost to the PCC of each pack was nil. The PCC provided no funding towards this initiative.

The remainder of the information requested is not held by the Police and Crime Commissioner.

## **Complaints**

If you think that the Police and Crime Commissioner has failed to supply information in accordance with the publication scheme, then you should write in the first instance, to the:

The PCC will aim to deal with your complaint within 10 working days. If you are dissatisfied with the response you can ask for the matter to be internally reviewed. Internal reviews will be completed promptly and a response given to you within 20 working days of your further request.
