# Fire and Rescue

Rescue people from road traffic collisions (RTC's) and protect people from serious harm in the event of a RTC
Ensure the staffing, equipment, training and services are in place for a RTC response

•Prevent or limit damage to property when rescuing or protecting people at a RTC

•HMRCFRS: "How well does the FRS work with partner organisations to promote road safety and reduce the numbers killed and seriously injured on the roads?"

Police

Investigation of serious and fatal collisions
Data analytics – recording and processing data where the police have been in attendance at a RTC. This data is shared with local authorities to shape engineering of the roads and to meet the DfT requirement for reporting collisions and casualties
